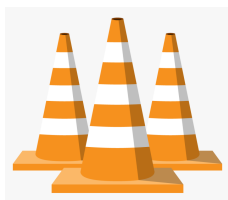

#### Change in Parking Lot Procedures

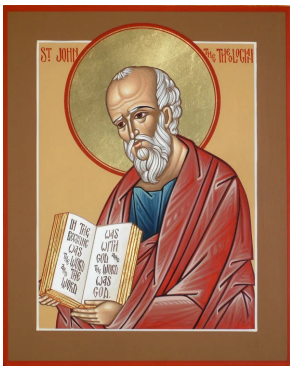

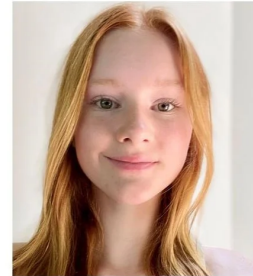
